Strong candidates will demonstrate strong leadership, excellent organizational skills and a passion for advancing our conservation goals through our community-focused approach to engaging communities in the Calumet Region.

## Responsibilities:

- Manage and supervise a 4-person crew, in collaboration with the Youth & Engagement Corps Manager, to implement engagement projects in the forest preserves.
- Assist with developing and training crew members in public engagement, local community organizing, and community-based conservation and ecology concepts
- Follow and implement curriculum to achieve listed deliverables in every phase of the training program
- Co-lead interview process for three crew members
